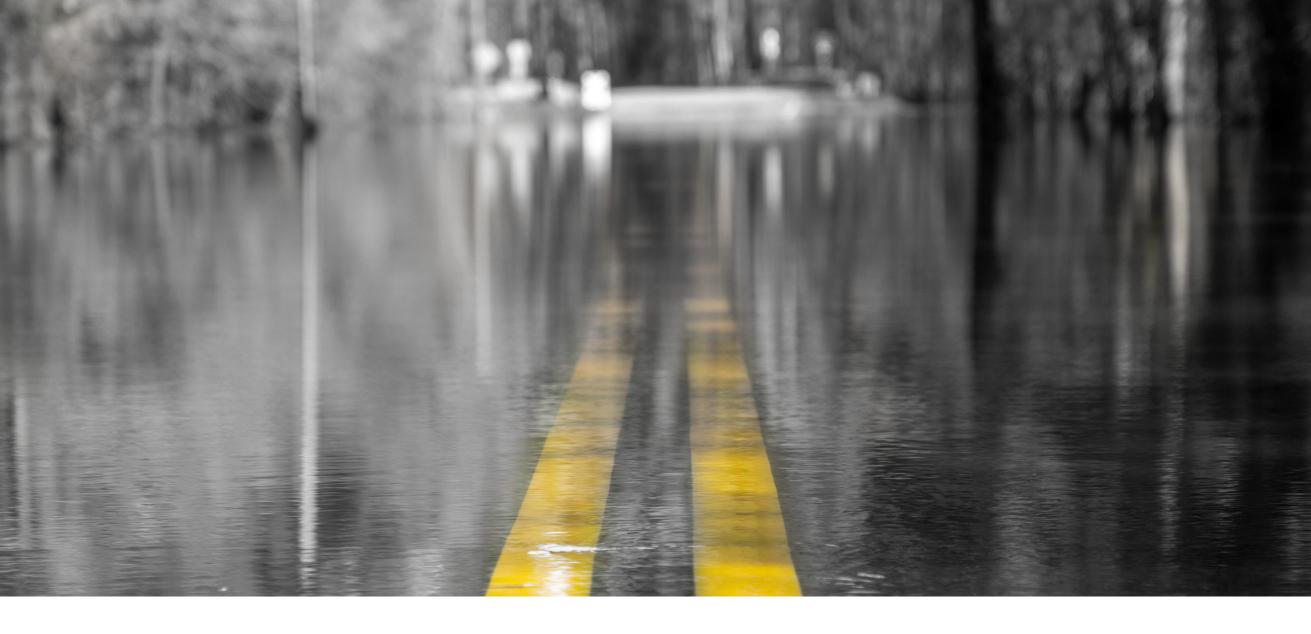
ANSWERING THE CALL: TRAFFIX' ROLE IN FLOOD RECOVERY FOR ASHEVILLE FACILITY



BACKGROUND

In November 2024, Asheville, North Carolina, experienced devastating flooding due to unprecedented rainfall caused by Hurricane Helene. Among the businesses impacted was IPEX, a leading North American piping and fittings manufacturer. IPEX's Asheville facility is one of several facilities that produces Silver Line products, a large nationally distributed brand for IPEX, and a pillar in the Asheville community as a major employer in the area for decades.





TRAFFIX' RESPONSE

TRAFFIX mobilized to support the recovery, providing a range of services centered around strategic problem-solving, operational agility, and customer-centric care. Services covered:



Rapid Communication and Action: TRAFFIX leadership and specialists quickly engaged with IPEX counterparts to understand IPEX's needs. TRAFFIX then developed a plan for managing the dynamic, complex situation, and maintained regular communications to ensure quick decision-making and overall project alignment.



Inventory Preparation: TRAFFIX coordinated teams and equipment to prepare inventory for customer shipments. The effort ensured that products were restored into the distribution network and contributed to IPEX maintaining business continuity.



Establishment of an Emergency Warehouse: Within a week, TRAFFIX sourced and set up a temporary warehouse in Greensboro, North Carolina. The site included indoor and outdoor storage spaces, labor for product handling, and a Warehouse Management System (WMS) for inventory reconciliation and tracking.

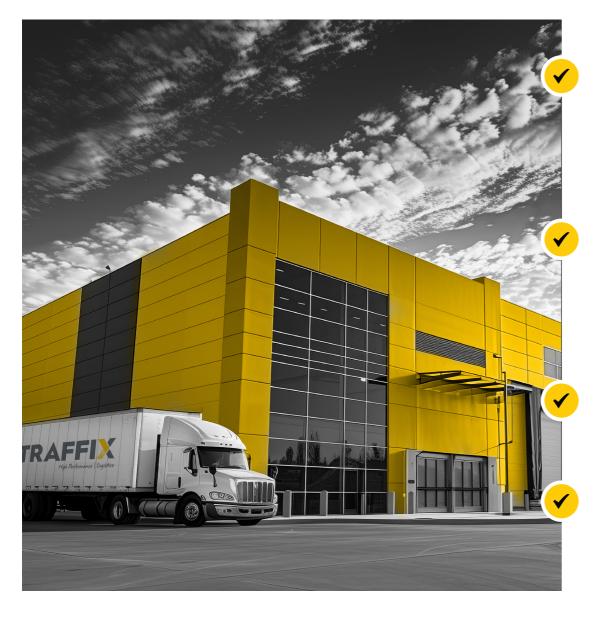


Emphasis on Safety and Quality: Health and safety protocols were rigorously implemented for workers, ensuring a secure environment during recovery efforts.



Yard Cleanup and Contaminated Product Removal: TRAFFIX sourcing team was able to secure a wide breadth of equipment and staffing, to safely process the recovery of inventory.

Operational Continuity: The temporary Greensboro warehouse enabled IPEX to continue fulfilling customer orders, minimizing backlogs and preserving customer relationships.

Accelerated Recovery: TRAFFIX' quick setup of the warehouse and labor deployment accelerated the redistribution process, reducing downtime for the impacted facility.

Customer Confidence: Visible progress reinforced IPEX's reliability and commitment to its customers.

Long-Term Planning: Insights gained during the recovery process informed strategic planning for future disaster resilience.

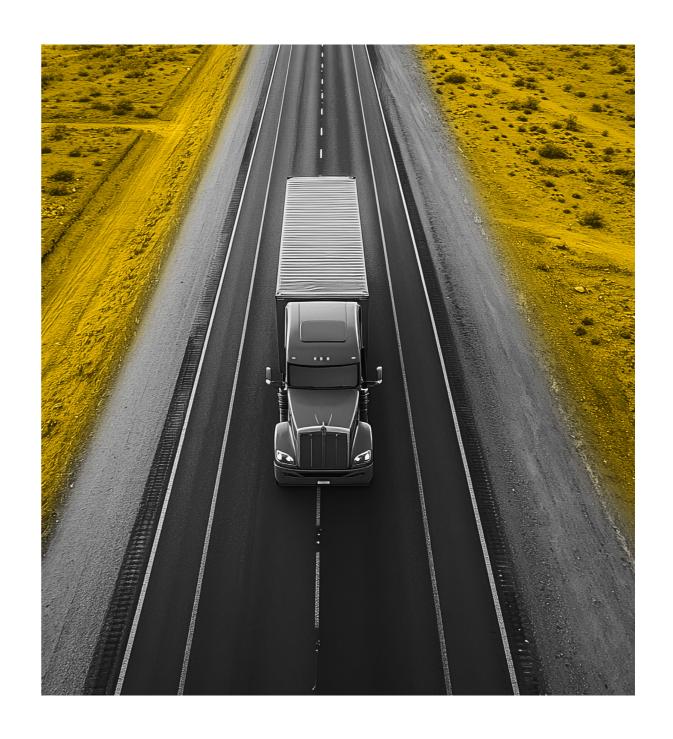
KEY TAKEAWAYS
